Congregation B'nai Israel Safety Protocols Membership Agreement

Congregation B'nai Israel (CBI) is committed to provide a friendly, peaceful, safe and secure environment for its members and guests. With this goal in mind, CBI has installed certain security features such as a perimeter fence with a security driveway gate, a security door at the synagogue main entrance accessible only with a security access code, security cameras, and an intrusion alarm system. CBI has also appointed a Safety Committee to assist in all matters of safety for members and guests. Furthermore, CBI has adopted the following safety protocols:

- 1. Only adult members in good standing shall be given the security access code for the main entrance.
- Members shall <u>NOT</u> give the security access code to <u>ANYONE</u>!
- Members shall <u>NOT</u> allow entry to any person not known to be a member of CBI. Members will refer such a person to a CBI Safety Committee member, a CBI Board member, or the Rabbi.
- 4. Any member or guest shall immediately report person(s) they consider suspicious, threatening, disruptive, or a potential threat to another member, guest or CBI property. That report should be made to the Rabbi, any Board Officer, and/or any member of the Safety Committee.
- 5. Any member or guest shall immediately report any injury or unexpected illness to the Rabbi, any Board Officer, and/or any member of the Safety Committee.
- 6. Any member or guest shall immediately report any hazard or potential hazard to the Rabbi, any Board Officer, and/or any member of the Safety Committee.
